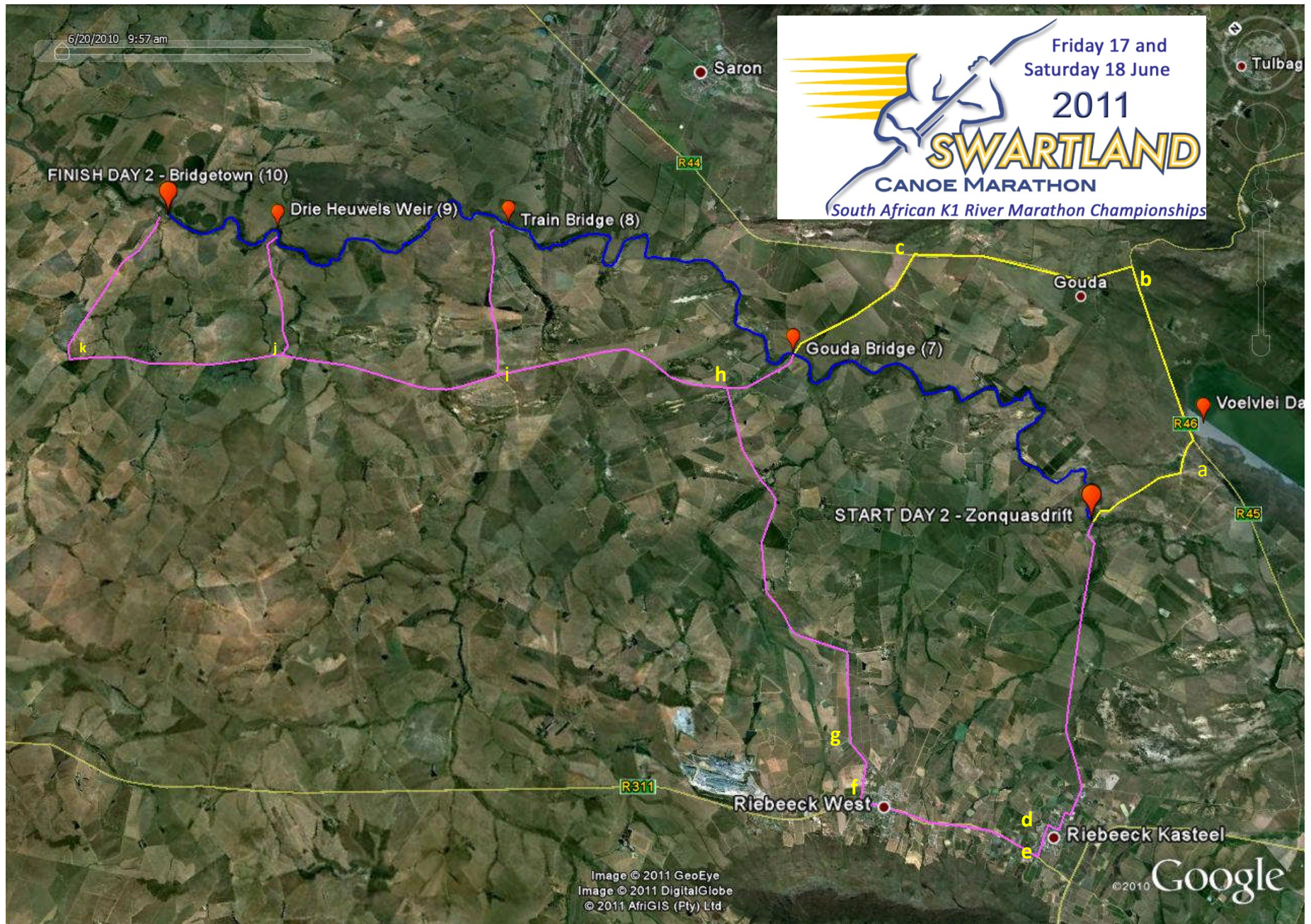


SECOND'S GUIDE – DAY 2



DAY 2

From Zonquasdrift – to Gouda Bridge – (7)

Option 1 - if the bridge at Zonquasdrift is not flooded

- Turn right as you exit the farm and follow the dirt road back to the R44, turn left at the stop street - see **a**
- Travel along the R44 until you get to the turn off for Gouda / Porterville. Turn left here - see **b**
- Follow the road and turn left at the sign to Riebeek West and Mooresburg. - see **c**
- Take the gravel road and carry on until you see the metal bridge over the river in front of you. Turn right onto the farm before the bridge and left again almost immediately, down towards the river.
- Supporters must please go onto the farm and park on the grass near the river. Please do NOT park or drive on the fields and do NOT park in the road or climb over the farmer's fence.

Option 2 - if the bridge at Zonquasdrift is flooded

Either follow the road back through Riebeek Kasteel over Hermon Bridge and onto the R44 and then follow the instructions as per option 1 above.

or

- Follow the road back to Riebeek Kasteel, at the four-way stop turn right - see **d**
- Follow the signs through Riebeek Kasteel to Riebeek West and turn right at the R31 1 - see **e**
- Once through Riebeek West, turn right at the top of the hill onto a tar road (which becomes gravel road - Station Road?)- see **f**
- Continue with this road for 1.8km, the last 800m on the west side of the rail track, turn right over the rail track - see **g**
- Keep going on this road for approximately 12km until you reach the T-Junction, turn right - see **h**
- Cross Gouda bridge and turn left just after the bridge and left again almost immediately, down towards the river.
- Supporters must please go onto the farm and park on the grass near the river. Please do NOT park or drive on the fields and do NOT park in the road or climb over the farmer's fence.

From Gouda Bridge - 7 to Bridgetown 10 via Train Bridge - 8 and Drieheuwels - 9

- Exit the farm and turn right back across the river
- Continue on the dirt road until you see a sign showing a right turn to train bridge - see **i**
- This road is very muddy in wet weather and it is advised not to travel it in an ordinary car if the weather is bad. Park at the farm and walk down to the river.
- Go back to the main road and continue along it. You can go and watch at Drie Heuwel's weir but you might then miss your paddler at the finish in Bridgetown.
- To get to Drie Heuwel turn right at signpost. - see **j**
- To get to Bridgetown turn right when you get to the tar road - see **k**
- Turn right at the signpost to Bridgetown
- Keep right and enter through the gate and find parking
